Bridge work at Camden Haven River

The NSW Roads and Traffic Authority (RTA) has formed an alliance with Thies Pty Ltd and Parsons Brinckerhoff Australia Pty Ltd to design and construct the 33 km dual carriageway upgrade of the Pacific Highway from Coopernook to Herons Creek (incorporating the Coopernook to Moorland and Moorland to Herons Creek projects). The project includes bypasses of the villages of South Moorland, Johns River and Kew. This project is jointly funded by the NSW and Australian governments and is scheduled for completion December 2009.

Piling for bridge

As part of construction for the Camden Haven River bridge, pile driving is necessary to support these structures. Piling involves lifting precast concrete piles into place with a crane and driving piles into the ground using a piling rig.

Piling is scheduled to occur for a period of approximately six weeks commencing Tuesday 9 September 2008 (weather permitting). Piling will be undertaken Monday to Friday, from 9am to 12 noon and 2pm to 5pm and Saturday, 9am to 12 noon.

Construction hours

General construction will occur Monday to Friday from 6am to 6pm and Saturday from 7am to 4pm. Nearby residents will be advised of any construction work occurring outside normal working hours. During construction every practical measure will be undertaken to minimise impacts on nearby residents and the environment.

The alliance apologises for any inconvenience this work may cause and will undertake every practical measure to minimise the impact on the residents and the environment and maintain safety.
